The 12 month blended course consists of distance learning, 12 one day workshops and students are supported by mentors.

Who is it for?

People just entering or considering housing development as a career and needing to develop an understanding of the technical, regulatory, financial and practical issues.

About the Course

It is a practical but rigorous course which has been developed following considerable discussion and debate with registered providers, local authorities and private developers over the past three years.

This fundamentally 'on the job' training course is designed to give those new to or inexperienced in affordable housing Development and/or Regeneration, a firm grounding to enable them to function effectively as a Development Officer/Project Manager.

Students and their Mentors appreciate the mix of distance learning (with 5 assignments), 9 one day workshops/seminars and the 'in service' training via Mentors, plus the ExtraNet facility which Adams Integra has specifically set up for the course.
